

Apartment Maintenance

Some key maintenance tips are provided below. For more details on a variety of finishes and appliances in your apartment, please refer to your Property and Warranties Manual.

Stone benchtops

For everyday routine cleaning, it is recommended that you use soapy water (with a mild detergent) and a damp cloth. Please avoid prolonged direct contact with hot surfaces or strong chemicals & solvents, including products that contain trichlotherane or methylene chloride, and any highly aggressive cleaning agents.

Sanitaryware

Sanitaryware and accessories should be cleaned with mild liquid detergent or soap and water. Do not use cream cleaners or citrus based cleaning products as they are abrasive and may damage the finish.

Tiles

Cleaning of your tiled surfaces is best done with normal household cleaning agents and scouring pads. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or metal scourers.

Timber flooring (if applicable)

It is recommended to have floor protectors on the base of all furniture located/used on the floorboards. These can be purchased from most supermarkets and all hardware stores.

Cleaning is best done with an anti-static mop for surface dirt and dust and a well rung out mop that is damp rather than wet. Be careful not to use excessive amounts of water as this can cause water damage to the boards requiring replacement. Do not use corrosive cleaning chemicals, steel wool, or polish. Always use a soft broom or recommended timber floor broom.

Drains

Never tip oil/fat down your drain as this can cause a build-up of grease and leads to blockages.

Drain cleaning products such as Draino are recommended to be used quarterly (3 months) in all frequently used areas (kitchen sink, bathroom basin and shower drains) – this will assist in keeping the drains clear of hair, soap scum and grease build up.
