If using solvent cleaners care should be taken to avoid contact with glazing sealant and other associated materials which may be affected by solvent, manufacturer's directions must be followed at all times when using solvents.

All surfaces should be washed down with clean water after applying cleaning solutions.

Surfaces may be dried using a squeegee or a clean lint free cloth.

Under no circumstances should harsh cleaners, alkaline solutions, blades, scrapers, abrasive or similar tools be used on any surfaces

Where there is a glass shower screen shelf installed, weight restriction of no more than 2kgs.

Mirrors:

Apply mild soap or detergent to glass either by spraying or using a grit free cloth or sponge saturated with the cleaning solution.

If using solvent cleaners care should be taken to avoid contact with glazing sealant and other associated materials which may be affected by solvent, manufacturer's directions must be followed at all times when using solvents.

All surfaces should be washed down with clean water after applying cleaning solutions.

Surfaces may be dried using a squeegee or a clean lint free cloth.

Under no circumstances should harsh cleaners, alkaline solutions, blades, scrapers, abrasive similar tools be used on any surfaces similar tools to be used on any surfaces

Wardrobes:

Apply a mild soap or detergent to the frames using a grit free cloth or sponge. If using solvent cleaners care should be taken to avoid contact with glazing sealant, manufacturer's directions must be followed at all times when using solvents.

All surfaces should be washed down with clean water after applying cleaning solutions.

Surfaces may be dried using a clean lint free cloth

Under no circumstances should harsh cleaners, alkaline solutions, blades, scrapers abrasive or similar tools be used on any surfaces

Weight restriction on top shelf is to be no more than 50kg
