Care & Maintenance Instructions

In order to ensure your CTA Storage Cage installation continues to look great, it requires regular monitoring and maintenance, up to and including regular cleaning and attention to any damage.

CTA Group recommend the following maintenance regime:

1. INITIAL COMMISSIONING



BRUSH/ SWEEP



INSPECT



WASH

Brush/ Sweep surrounding area, with a Ph neutral detergent, warm water and a brush to remove any excess dirt and grime, inspect for loose fittings.

2. ONGOING MONTHLY & BIANNUAL MAINTENANCE



BRUSH/ SWEEP



INSPECT

Brush/ Sweep, inspect for loose fittings

When installed correctly CTA Storage Cages are proven to last the test of time, however it is recommended the installation is inspected on a regular basis for any damage or dislodgement caused by unforeseen circumstances such as vandal abuse or damage from vehicles.

On a regular basis CTA Storage Cages should be checked for loose fittings.

Carrying out the recommended maintenance instructions will ensure your CTA Storage Cages will last the test of time, and remain secure.
