

Care & Maintenance Instructions

In order to ensure your SureSteel® Tactile Installation continues to look great and more importantly retain compliance to the Australian Standards, they require regular monitoring and maintenance, up to and including cleaning and replacement of dislodged or damaged indicators.

CTA Group recommend the following maintenance regime:

1. INITIAL COMMISSIONING

It is important that your initial installation is cleaned and in most cases where CTA has supplied and installed the product, it will be conducted by the installation team.

2. ONGOING DAILY MAINTENANCE

Depending on the type of installation and aesthetic requirement, SureSteel® Tactile indicators should be swept clean of any debris on a daily basis. Note this is also an important safety requirement. Whilst SureSteel® Tactiles provide the highest possible level of safety (highest in the industry), some debris such as leaves and/or sand etc. can impair the frictional properties of pedestrian surfaces.

3. ONGOING MONTHLY & BIANNUAL MAINTENANCE

Whilst SureSteel® Tactile indicators are manufactured from a single piece of 316 marine grade stainless steel and will not break or come loose, it is important the installation is inspected on a regular basis for any damage or dislodgement caused by unforeseen circumstances, such as vandalism.

On a biannual basis CTA recommends that SureSteel® is washed using a pH neutral detergent, with warm water and a deck broom to remove any excess dirt and grime.

Carrying out the recommended maintenance instructions will ensure your SureSteel® Tactile installation will last the test of time, remain safe and guarantee you conform with the standards at all times.
