5.0 INSTALLATION METHOD

PREPARATION

All wall & floor areas are free from debris prior to all applications by dusting, sweeping etc

WATERPROOFING

Not applicable for this project by Zara Marble and Granite Qld. This application by others.

• INTERNAL & EXTERNAL FLOOR TILING

All floor tiles are laid on screed sand /cement mortar bed (1:3 ratio) where falls are required Floor tiles are directly installed to the level concrete substrate with Bostik Adhesive.

FLOOR TILE GROUTING

Floor tiles have been grouted with Mapei, Ardex or Bostik.

WALL TILING

All wall tiles are adhesive fixed to plasterboard or rendered finish with Mapei and Bostik.

WALL TILE GROUTING

All wall tiles have been grouted with Mapei and Bostik.

JOINT SEALING

Internal

Internal Corners: 'Floor to Wall Junctions' – Beaded by battery operated gun using Sika matching colour Silicone

External Corners: 'Vertical Junctions' - Beaded by battery operated gun using Sika matching colour Silicone

External

'Floor perimeter to Internal Corners' - Beaded by battery operated gun using Sika matching colour Silicone

6.0 PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

MAINTENANCE

INSPECTION

A visual inspection should be carried out by the clients & or building manager on a monthly basis to check for any problems arising from structural movements or material reacting to the environmental conditions and /or a cleaning regime.

CLEANING METHODS FOR CERAMIC, VITRIFIED & STONE TILES

- General maintenance cleaning of tiles should be done with a mild detergent and water and applied with a nylon brush or rug and removed with a squeegee, similar to glass cleaning
- No high-pressure water, acids or strong alkaline detergents should be used
- All materials used should be cleaned in the same way, with highly trafficked floor areas receiving a greater frequency of attention
- A sample area should be tried in a more conspicuous locations prior to cleaning all over to test the cleaning agent for potential damage/ staining
- Regularly sweep and wash with a PH neutral detergent mixed with warm water using soft cotton cloth dry and buff in a circular motion.
- The material may darken slightly due to some absorption but the colour should return as the moisture evaporates
- Cleaning agents containing either acid, alkali, bleach or other corrosive chemicals should not be used.
- Do not use abrasives to scour stubborn marks as this will scratch the surface
- Specialists should address stains that cannot be removed by cleaning methods described above.

MAINTENANCE

Reconstituted Stone

Surfaces require little maintenance to keep them looking like new. For everyday routine cleaning of reconstituted stone wipe the surface with a mild detergent with warm soapy water with a clean damp cloth. Use a cloth only allocated for the bench tops and not a cloth that you use to wash the dishes etc as it may transfer oils and other contaminants to the surface.

Reconstituted stone is a virtually a non-porous and it will not require sealing. Never attempt to seal this product.

Avoid contact with harsh cleaning agents that contain trichlorethane or methylene chloride, such as paint removers, strippers and oven cleaners that have high alkaline/pH levels. Should the surface be accidentally exposed to any of these damaging products, rinse immediately with water to neutralize the effect and buff with a clean dry cloth.

Natural Stone

Use a clean, soft microfiber cloth to clean stone surfaces with a neutral cleaner, stone soap, or a mild liquid dishwashing detergent and warm water. Rinse the surface thoroughly after washing with the soap solution and dry with a soft cloth.

Travertine benchtops are sealed with Stainstop or reapable product.

General

To get the extra life and preserve your natural stone place coasters under all glasses, particularly those containing alcohol or citrus juices.

If any spills blot with a paper towel immediately and wipe the area with water and mild and rinse several times. Dry the area thoroughly with a soft cloth. Repeat as necessary.

soap

Avoid placing hot pots and other items directly onto the stone benchtop.

Use cutting boards as direct contact will cause sealant to eventually wear out.

Resealing is highly recommended 6-12 or longer months depending on area on frequently used areas to maintain the nonporous layer on surface and protect the naturally porous stone which helps prevent stains.



HOW TO MAINTAIN YOUR NEWLY TREATED SURFACES

EVERDAY:

- Mop up any spills immediately
- We recommend cleaning with warm water and a small amount of 'NEUTRAL CLEAN'

'NEUTRAL CLEAN' is a super concentrated, non-acidic, phosphate free neutral cleaner. It eliminates soap scum build-up and hard water deposits when used regularly

STUBBORN STAINS:

Greases, soap scum, heavy grime build-up and mildew stains.

- Mop up any spills immediately
- We recommend cleaning with a diluted, bio-degradable phosphate free alkaline cleaner called 'D-GREASE'

'D-GREASE' is industrial strength and must be diluted in accordance with instructions on the product for 'normal cleaning'. NOTE: Excessive/undiluted use of product will damage sealed surface

Materials which contain colouring matter such as tomato sauce, cheese, dairy products, food colouring, tea and red wine.

- Mop up any spills immediately
- We recommend cleaning with good quality bleach. Please read the instructions for cleaning on the bleach bottle and carefully follow dilution instructions

IN GROUND DIRT, SCUFF MARKS etc.

- Mop up any spills immediately
- Apply small amount 'MISTER CLEAN' cream cleanser and work into effected area only.
- Keep cleanser moist with water and/or small amount of 'NEUTRAL CLEAN'

WE RECOMMEND

Placing stoppers on all furniture to prevent scratching, rusting and unnecessary damage to tiles

WE DO NOT RECOMMEND

using solvent based cleaners such as xylene, acetone, mineral turps, kerosene, methylated spirits, rust and scale cleaners/removers, lime cleaners or any acidic cleaner.

CLEANING CAUTIONS

Cleaners containing acid should never be used for routine maintenance. Acidic cleaners, even a light solution of vinegar and water, will etch polished natural stone and eventually damage tile. Acidic cleaners will also cause grout to deteriorate and strip the pigmentation from the grout. Heavy-duty cleaning may become necessary if tile cleaning has been neglected.

ALWAYS CONDUCT A TEST SAMPLE before apply any cleaning products for suitability on your surface.
